

Furnace Creek Inn DEATH VALLEY

FURNACE CREEK INN, located at sea level, is a luxurious metropolitan hotel within the desolate wastes of Death Valley. The Inn commands the colorful sweep of Death Valley and the towering ranges of tortured rock which hem the Valley in. The Inn, with its large lobby and commodious dining room; its spreading wings of bedrooms; its its rock-walled fountains, is architecturally in harmony with the fascinating Valley. The rooms of the Inn, designed in tasteful simplicity, are modernly furnished. Each room has ample closet space and a bath. All of Death Valley and its hills lie just beyond the walls of Furnace Creek Inn. From Furnace Creek Inn the roads thread through Death Valley to every historic and scenic spot: To Furnace Creek Ranch, the green oasis of Death Valley; to the abandoned borax works made famous by the Twenty-Mule Teams; to the great beds of salt and the deep salt pools at the lowest point in the United States; to abandoned mines and deserted mining cities which boomed and died on the edges of Death Valley. Dante's View on the Black Mountains, six thousand feet above Death Valley, dominates a scene of majestic splendor: the vivid Death Valley which Furnace Creek Inn has stripped of all its perils that the world might enjoy its dynamic beauty.
